His third film Woman on Fire Looks for Water is only the second Malaysian feature film ever selected for Venice Orrizonti section. Angelos Rallis started his career in theatre and as a director for ERTTV in Greece before moving to Sweden and the UK to complete his graduate and post-graduate studies in Film, Anthropology and Photography. His early work in video and photography has been published in international newspapers such as Ethnos and The Guardian and has been used by press agencies and NGOs around the world. His visual and artistic approach, in the mode of observational style, resides somewhere between contemplative cinema, theatre and creative documentary with fictional aesthetics.

This audacious quest, told with humor and archival footage, is accompanied by Paul Jarman's evocative score, celebrating this remarkable yet little-known chapter of Australian history.

MICHAEL DILLON has been filming and directing Adventure Documentaries for over 50 years. He worked as a filmmaker for Sir Edmund Hillary for 25 years and filmed three Everest Expeditions including a climb of it from Sea Level. Films he has produced include Hillary-Ocean to Sky, A Fare to Remember - The Great Taxi Adventure and Everest - Sea to Summit. He was recently awarded the Grand Prize by the International Federation of Mountain Film Festivals for Lifetime Achievement, the first awardee ever from the Southern Hemisphere.



Serpent groves, once protected by ance stral rituals, served as sanctuaries for dive rse life and sustained the environment 2024 / India/ Malayalam/ 4' through sacred ponds and fertile soil. Punarjani aims to raise awareness about preserving the remaining groves and recognizing that their destruction threatens not just nature but humanity itself.
